Rules on Back

USBC Youth High 5 Rules and Format

1. Bowl round robin baker format. With the last game being a position round
(The Number of position rounds may be changed depending on number of teams)
2. Unless unusual low entries, teams will be split into two division one scratch and one handicap based on team average. At the discretion of the Tournament Manager.
3. Use last year's high average 15 games or more. If no last year's average, then use current average as of November 5th, if neither average then must bowl scratch (220 average.)
4. Handicap division (Total team average divided by 5) 90 percent of 220
5. Prize fund returned 100 Percent. Top 2 teams in each division receive awards and scholarships. And a sponsor plaque.
6. Scholarship funds will be forwarded to SMART (Account # 8672) for deposit and final distribution.
7. Open to current USBC youth members only
8. Each center encouraged to send 1 team made up of 5 bowlers. All 5 bowlers must bowl league in same center. Must have a minimum of 2 male and 2 female bowlers on each team. Must be Idaho/Washington USBC member
9. Substitutes may come from another center if approved by the Tournament director. Substitutes average must be the same or lower than the person being replaced.
10. Scoring will be handicap pin fall plus 30 pins for a win and 15 for a tie
11. If a tie exists after the final game in a paying position a one game baker roll off will be used to break the tie.
12. Any conflicts will be resolved by tournament management
13. Any ties for award position will be broken by a 1 game baker Bowl off.
14. Participants will not wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling and illegal substances or inappropriate language/gestures during competition. Suitable attire is required. No Hats
