## **2024 TOURNAMENT RULES**

- 1. USBC rules and regulations will govern this tournament.
- 2. Entry is limited to Idaho USBC certified youth members only. Fees per bowler are as follows: \$22 for Singles event, \$22 for Doubles event, \$22 for Team event plus \$5 for Each Optional Handicap and Scratch (boys and girls in scratch) All Events.

Total entry per bowler participating in all of the events will be \$76.

- 3. Coaches/Instructors or Proprietors must submit certified standing sheets as of November 1st, 2024. (Standing sheets are needed to verify averages and in the event of substitutions).
- 4. The highest previous year certified league average, minimum of 21 games, as of July 31 will be used. If no last year average Bowler can use current average as of November 1<sup>st</sup>. Bowlers without one of these average requirements must bowl scratch (220 average).
- 5. Any falsification of average or eligibility will result in disqualification of bowler.
- 6. Entries must be postmarked on or before **November 4th**, **2024.** Checks, money orders, local association or proprietor checks made payable to IDAHO STATE USBC will be accepted. Entries must be paid in full. To guarantee times enter online! **NO REFUNDS.**
- 7. Teams will consist of any four members. MIXED TEAMS ARE ALLOWED.
- 8. Handicap will be 90% of 220.
- 9. Bowlers entering doubles must also enter singles on one of their double's events.
- 10. Competition will consist of three (3) games in each event. First score bowled in any event shall count towards all-events.
- 11. **Multiple entries** will be permitted in the team and doubles events. At least 2 bowlers in team event and 1 bowler in doubles event must change for re-entry.
- 12. Tournament management reserves the right in an emergency to permit an individual who has already bowled in the tournament to substitute if no substitute who has not already bowled in the tournament is available. Rule 11 shall apply for All-Events.
- 13. Awards will be given for at least 1 of each 5 entries in each division and in each event. In case of a tie for first place in any event, co-championships shall be declared, and duplicate awards will be given.
- 14. Scratch awards will be given for high scratch team, high scratch doubles, high scratch singles. Ties for first will receive duplicate awards.
- 15. High paid scratch all events winners, Boy and Girl, will receive a paid spot in the 2025 Teen Masters Championships.
- 16.SCHOLARSHIPS will be awarded for at least 1<sup>st</sup> place Handicap in each event in each division. Also high scratch All-Events boy and girl in each division. In case of a tie duplicate scholarships will be given. All awards and scholarship fees will be returned 100%. Scholarship funds will be forwarded to SMART Account #9680 for deposit and final distribution. Refer USBC Rule 309.
- 17. Youth participants will not wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, an illegal substance or inappropriate language/gestures during competition. No Hats!
- 18.USBC Code of Conduct will be strictly enforced. No one will be allowed in the bowling area except bowlers, scorers and tournament officials. All bowlers shall remain in the bowling area during competition. Anyone failing to comply will be subject to disqualification.
- 19. Bowlers must check-in at least 30 minutes prior to squad time.
- 20. The tournament director reserves the right to settle all disputes unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329. Idaho State USBC Youth tournament director reserves the right to accept or reject any participant USBC Rule 303.
