TOURNAMENT RULES:

- 1. Eligibility: This tournament is open to all Seniors aged 50 and over who are residents of the State of Idaho and members of the Idaho State USBC, except for Professionals. Seniors who are not members of USBC must purchase membership prior to bowling the tournament.
- 2. Entering Average: Entrants shall use their highest USBC average from sanctioned league for the previous season (2024-25 or Summer League 2025) based on a minimum of 21 games or more. If neither average the bowler may use current average as of Nov. 1, 2025, based on minimum of 21 games. All others shall bowl scratch. Handicap will be based on 90% of 220 in all divisions.
- 3. Rules 319d reporting all prior Prize Winnings (which has changed, please refer to the 2025-26 Playing Rules book) and 319e (Average Adjustment for Entry) will be required by all bowlers. Tournament manager reserves the right to rerate or reject any entry prior to bowling.
- 4. Prizes:
 - 1. Winners in each division will receive a paid entry to the National Championship Tournament. The National Tournament for men and women will be Separate, but bowled at the same time and place. The second-place winners will be invited if the first-place winners are unable to attend. If neither can attend, no one will represent the division.
 - 2. All prize monies collected in each division will be returned 100% to the participants in each division Prize fund will be based on one (1) in six (6) entries in each division.
- 5. Ties Co-Winners will be declared for prizes and awards. The champion for National competition shall be determined by the highest single game with handicap to break the tie. All other ties in payout shall split the positions evenly.
- 6. A total of six (6) games must be bowled to qualify for State Champion in all divisions. They will be bowled in two (2) separate blocks. Bowlers may bowl all six games on the same day or 2 different days.
- 7. Entry fee will be refundable at the discretion of the Tournament Director. i.e., death, injury, health issues, etc. prior to bowling the first game of the tournament.
- 8. Bowlers shall be required to check in one (1) hour prior to scheduled time to bowl. USBC membership cards may be required for check in.
- 9. Bowlers shall not be allowed to practice on Tournament lanes within one (1) hour of time scheduled to bowl tournament.
- 10. Use of abrasives and cleaners will be prohibited. No extra holes in bowling bowl allowed. Bowling balls can not be cleaned during tournament play.
- The Annual meeting of the Idaho State Seniors will be held on Saturday Nov. 1, 2025, at 6:00 PM in the meeting room at Westy's Garden Lane. All senior bowlers are welcome to attend.
- 12. Any rules not covered herein will be in accordance with USBC playing rules.
